How to apply: The link for filling the online Application Form can be accessed through Institute website www.nitj.ac.in. The candidates are required to apply online and there is no requirement to send the Hard Copy of the Application Form to the Institute.

Last date for submission of online Application Form is 16.08.2024 (11.00 PM).

B) Eligibility Criteria

- The candidate should be a minimum Class XII qualified with an aggregate of minimum 50% marks.
- The subject combination at Class XII level should be as under:
Physics and Chemistry should have been compulsorily studied alongwith Mathematics/Applied Mathematics/Biology/Biotechnology/Biological Studies/Biochemistry combination.
- The candidate must have appeared in the National Common Entrance Test-2024.

Note: Mere appearing in the National Common Entrance Test-2024 will not ensure admission to the 4-Year Integrated B.Sc.-B.Ed. programme under ITEP. The admissions will be made as per the Admission Procedure mentioned in this Advertisement.

C) Admission Procedure

- The candidates will be required to fill the Online Application Form.
- Based on the number of available seats (category-wise) and eligible candidates, the applications will be scrutinized by the Admission Committee in order of merit of the score obtained in the National Common Entrance Test-2024.
- In case, there is a tie of the score obtained in the National Common Entrance Test-2024, the candidate older in age will be placed above the candidate who is younger in age.
- Based on the National Common Entrance Test-2024 score, a detailed merit list of the candidates (in order of merit) will be displayed on the Institute Website.
- Round-I:** The list of provisionally selected candidates as per the category-wise seats will be displayed on the Institute website i.e. www.nitj.ac.in as per the schedule mentioned in this Advertisement.
- The provisionally selected candidates during **Round-I** will be required to deposit their Institute Fee online as per the given schedule for confirming their admission.
- Non-submission of the Institute Fee will be deemed as automatic withdrawal of the allotted seat. No further chance will be granted in any case.
- Round-II:** The vacant seats will be displayed on the Institute website i.e. www.nitj.ac.in.
- Against the vacant seats, the list of the provisionally selected candidates will be displayed.

- iii. Institute Fee once deposited shall not be refunded in any case.
- iv. Hostel facility will be provided to all girl students. Limited Hostel facility is available for the boy students.
- v. All the admissions are provisional till these are confirmed by the Academic Section of the Institute. If at any stage it is noticed that the candidate has submitted false information/false document, his/her admission will be cancelled and no refund of fee whatsoever will be made.
