- 3. Bids will be opened online as per time given schedule.
- 4. Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary/relevant documents have been uploaded with the bid which should be duly signed and stamped. The duly signed and stamped copies of Terms & Conditions of the tender, reply of the Questionnaire of Plant & Machinery and other documents of the Tender & Annexures must be uploaded, failing which their bids may be rejected.

- 14. Delivery time is the essence of the contract and must be met with.
- 15. The Director may accept a tender in part or whole of the quantity offered, reject any tender without assigning any reasons and may not accept the lowest bidder. Further in case of any doubt/dispute, the decision of the Director of the Institute shall be final.
- 16. The offer shall be kept valid for minimum 120 days.
- 17. The tenderer should not have been debarred and/ or blacklisted by any Central Government/ or any State Government Department(s). This must be <u>supported by an affidavit as per format given in **Annexure-"D"**.</u>
- 18. If any information furnished by the bidder is, at any stage found to be incorrect/false/fabricated, the Institute shall have the absolute right to forfeit the EMD, warranty/performance guarantees or/and security deposits, in addition to cancellation of contract, and in accordance with law, such other actions may be taken like black-listing of thebidder etc.

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### **TENDER EVALUATION**

Institute will evaluate all the proposals to determine whether these are complete in all respects as specified in the tender document. Evaluation of the proposals shall be done in two stages as:

### (a) Stage – I (Technical Evaluation):

(i) Institute shall evaluate the technical bid(s) to determine the following like the bid qualifies the essential eligibility criteria or not, the tenderer has submitted the EMD & Tender fee or not, any computational errors have been made or not, all the documents have been properly filled or otherwise, all the documents have been submitted/ uploaded with technical bid or not, the specifications, Make/Model, Catalogue of quoted Equipment /Item are as per requirement tender specifications or not, Authorization of Dealer / Distributor/ Exclusive Agent certificate from manufacturer is in order or not, Sales & service policy of equipment / item during warranty period and after warranty period will also be seen, location of their authorized service center will also be seen for evaluation etc.

After evaluation of technical bid(s), a list of the qualifying tenderer (s)/ bidder

s) shall be made. Short-listed tenderer(s) will be informed of the date, time and place of opening of financial bid(s) and they may attend or depute their authorized representative/s to attend the schedule of opening of financial bid(s) on the scheduled date and time, if they wish to do so. The representative(s) should have a letter of authority to attend the price bid(s) opening event.

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### PART - II (e-FINANCIAL BID):

- a) Bidders should offer the rates as per the format of BOQ as available on CPP Portal. Detailed bill of material/quantity is also to be provided along with the price breakup of each item as per requirement of the tendered specification of the equipment in the online price bid at <a href="CPP Portal">CPP Portal</a>.
  - Note: The quoted amount as filled in the Annexure(s) of online financial bid and detailed bill of material/quantity provided with price break up of each item in the online financial bid should be tallied and both must be same, otherwise bid will be treated invalid.
- **b)** Rates should be quoted in Indian Currency only.
- c) Custom, GST or any other taxes, Education Cess and other charges must be mentioned in the price bid. The financial evaluation/comparison will be made after including all the above mentioned charges/taxes.

#### ARBITRATION:

In case of any dispute or difference arising out in connection with the tender conditions/job order/Contract, the Institute and the Seller/Service Provider will address the dispute/difference for a mutual resolution and failing which, the matter shall be referred for arbitration to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Institute.

The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the venue of arbitration shall be at Jalandhar only. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

#### JURISDICTION:

The courts at Jalandhar alone will have the jurisdiction to trial any matter, dispute or reference between parties arising out of this tender / contract. It is specifically agreed that no court outside and other than Jalandhar Court shall have jurisdiction in the matter.

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### (TERMS AND CONDITIONS (FOR THE SUPPLY OF GOODS, EQUIPMENT /ITEM)

- Rate should be quoted F.O.R NIT Jalandhar and in INR only.
- 2. The institute being government educational institute is having Excise and Custom duty exemption in terms of government notification No. 51/96-customs Dt. 23-7-1996 and No. 10/97-central excise Dt. 1-3- 1997 as amended from time to time, therefore taxes be quoted accordingly and this must be depicted in Price Bid clearly.
- 3. GST or any other chargeable duty where applicable must be specifically mentioned, failing which no tax or duty will be allowed at subsequent stage.

### **Service Level Agreement**

- To provide Internet Router Port at ISP Gateway for required Bandwidth with minimum subnet of 32 Public IP addresses including Reverse Lookups configured at these IP's. Domain Name Services must be provided to NITJ for IPv4 (And for IPv6 whenever asked for).
- 3. Packet Losses: Less than 1 % (Average over 1000 ping) at any given point of time to any part of globe.



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- 4. Latency: Less than 100ms from the Institute to ISP's tier 1 peering point. Latency will be randomly checked on daily basis. In case of non-adherence latency limit, the link will be considered as down with effect from time of detection till the time it is restored.
- 5. Network Availability (uptime): More than 99.5 % per month.
- 6. The ISP will be responsible for their compatibility with Firewall and Central switch.
- 7. The ISP will be responsible to provide and implementation of software at the client side for bandwidth Utilization, uptime, and packet loss and to check the bandwidth speed.
- 8. The ISP will be responsible for the comprehensive maintenance and testing of hardware, for which NIT Jalandhar will not make any extra payment
- 9. Reports for performance, monitoring / usage to be submitted by the ISP on weekly or monthly basis or as per requirement of the Institute. Providing MRTG reporting of the Internet Connectivity port on the internet updated every 10-20 minutes.
- 10. Demonstration of the uplink and downlink from server located at NITJ as and when required.
- 11. Downtime Calculation: Downtime shall be calculated as (Total Time Down Time) X 100 /Total Time. Deduction in payment will be made for downtime in the quarterly bills raised by the ISP.
- 12. The response time for attending the faults will be 1 hour after they are reported to the ISP. The ISP will rectify the faults within 12 hours failing which; the vendor will arrange temporary replacements. The services shall be provided 24 X 7 days in a week.

If the network availability is less than 96%, the performance shall be deemed to be dismal and the order may be terminated by serving one-month notice.

Downtime due to the following situations will not be considered for the purpose of penalty:

- a) Link down due to power failure / or any situation which are beyond the control of service provider.
- b) Due to schedule maintenance by the Service Provider, with prior approval of Institute.

### (A) PAYMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Annual Recurring (bandwidth) charges shall be payable on quarterly basis at the end

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of the quarter, for this the Service Provider will raise the bill at-least two weeks in advance before the end of each quarter.

### (B) INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING:

Project should be completed within 6-8 weeks from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent (LOI) / Work order. All the aspects of safe delivery, installation, commissioning and uplink of the connectivity shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Service Provider. The Commissioning of the service shall be at the premises of Data Centre of IT Building, NIT Jalandhar and the full commissioned bandwidth upload and download shall be shown by the ISP on the Institute Server/Machine. The supply shall actually be deemed to have been completed on the actual date of successful testing by the committee constituted for this purpose. The ISP is advised to report about the same to the institute for testing the link/services by the committee as and when it gets ready.

If the Service Provider fails to uplink the connectivity by the specified date, then the penalty at the rate of 1% per week of the total order value subject to maximum of 10% of total order value will be deducted.

### (C) CONTRACT PERIOD:

The contract is initially for a period of one year and the same may be extended for a period of three years maximum subject to the satisfactory performance of the link after which it shall be deemed to have expired even if there are outages on the link after the expiry of the contract. No payment whatsoever shall be admissible to the service provider after the expiry of the contract. Decision of the Institute in this regard shall be final, conclusive and binding on the ISP.

The agreed price would be applicable throughout the contract period. No hike in price would be admissible; however, if the prices are reduced on any account, benefit of the same should be passed on to Institute.

### (D) TENDER PREPARATION COST:

The tenderer shall solely bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid, including the site visit etc. The Institute shall in no case be responsible or liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tender process. In no case such costs shall be reimbursed by the Institute.

### (E) AWARD OF CONTRACT:

(i) The institute will award the contract *to ISP* on the basis of L1 rates.

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### (F) COMMENCEMENT OF CONTRACT:

The Service Provider shall commence the work from the date of receipt of acceptance of the Letter of Intent (LOI). Project will be completed within 6-8 weeks from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent (LOI) / Work order. All the aspects of safe delivery, installation, commissioning and uplink of the connectivity shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Service Provider. The Commissioning of the service shall be at the premises of Data Centre of IT Building, NIT Jalandhar

### (G) PERFORMANCE SECURITY:

The Service Provider shall be required to furnish a Performance Security @ 3% of the total value of the contract within 15 days from the date of commencement of the Internet Lease Line (1:1) in the form of Demand Draft by any nationalized bank in favor of Director, Dr B R Ambedkar National Institute of Technology, Jalandhar for contract period of one year.

The Performance Security as furnished by the Service Provider shall remain valid for a period of sixty days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the Service Provider under the agreement to be executed by and between the Institute and the Service Provider.

In case the period of contract is extended further by the Institute in consultation with the Service Provider, the validity of Performance Security shall also be extended by the Service Provider accordingly so that such Performance Security shall remain valid for a period of sixty days after the expiry of the obligations of the Service Provider for the extended period.

### (H) SERVICE PROVIDER OBLIGATIONS:

- a. The Service Provider shall be responsible for providing the 500 Mbps (1:1) uncompressed and unshared leased line internet connectivity at Institute all the time throughout the contract period.
- The 500 Mbps bandwidth should be provided through an underground fiber link on ring terminating in Data Centre of IT Building, NITJ, and the output interface should be Fiber (10G)
- c. The Service Provider shall be responsible for installation, commissioning and configuring of hardware and uplink of connectivity. The ISP will maintain the OFC and equipment (Mux, Modems and Router etc to be provided by the ISP) to provide Internet Services in NITJ Data Centre of the IT Building for efficient running at all times of the contract. The institute shall provide a Layer 3 Switch to be configured by the ISP.



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- d. Liaisons (if required) with other firm(s) for obtaining point to point connectivity between ISP node and Institute, shall be the responsibility of the Service Provider.
- e. The Service Provider would insure that the local loop provisioning does not violate any regulations as laid by Government of India / TRAI in respect of such links / networks. Service Provider shall be responsible for making all the payments towards the local loop charges / rentals/ WPC charges etc.
- f. The Service Provider will do preventive maintenance once a quarter for upkeep of the systems running. The schedule will have to be adhered to strictly by the ISP.
- g. NIT Jalandhar will not purchase any Hardware and ISP will have to provide all the required hardware on latest technology for installation, commissioning and configuring of hardware and uplink of connectivity in the Data Centre of the Institute and will also be fully responsible for its maintenance.
